The Department of Justice has received your April 3, 2015 request for copies of "documents containing information concerning the total number of voters located as a result of the investigation conducted by the Attorney General's Office from the Secretary of State's office on challenged voter affidavits; qualified voter affidavits and domicile affidavits signed by the voters...." This letter serves as an initial five-day response to your request.

Since the documents requested may contain confidential information and/or information that is exempt from the Right to Know law, the Department cannot immediately produce the documents at this time. Our office will respond to your document request within 30 days. If we cannot complete the review and production of the requested documents by that date, then we will then notify you of when the documents will become available.

Dear Mr. Adams,

This letter is in response to your Right-to-Know request seeking the total number of voters located as a result of the investigation conducted by this office regarding voters who executed challenged voter affidavits, qualified voter affidavits and/or domicile affidavits during 2012 election and did not respond to the confirmation letters sent by the Secretary of State because the letters were returned as "undeliverable as addressed." Although we do not have any specific documents responsive to your request, 470 voters who executed challenged voter affidavits during 2012 election have been confirmed thus far, however the investigation is ongoing. To date the New Hampshire Department of Justice has expended 234 investigator and attorney hours, 200 support staff hours and 21 staff hours at the New Hampshire Information and Analysis Center in the course of this investigation.
