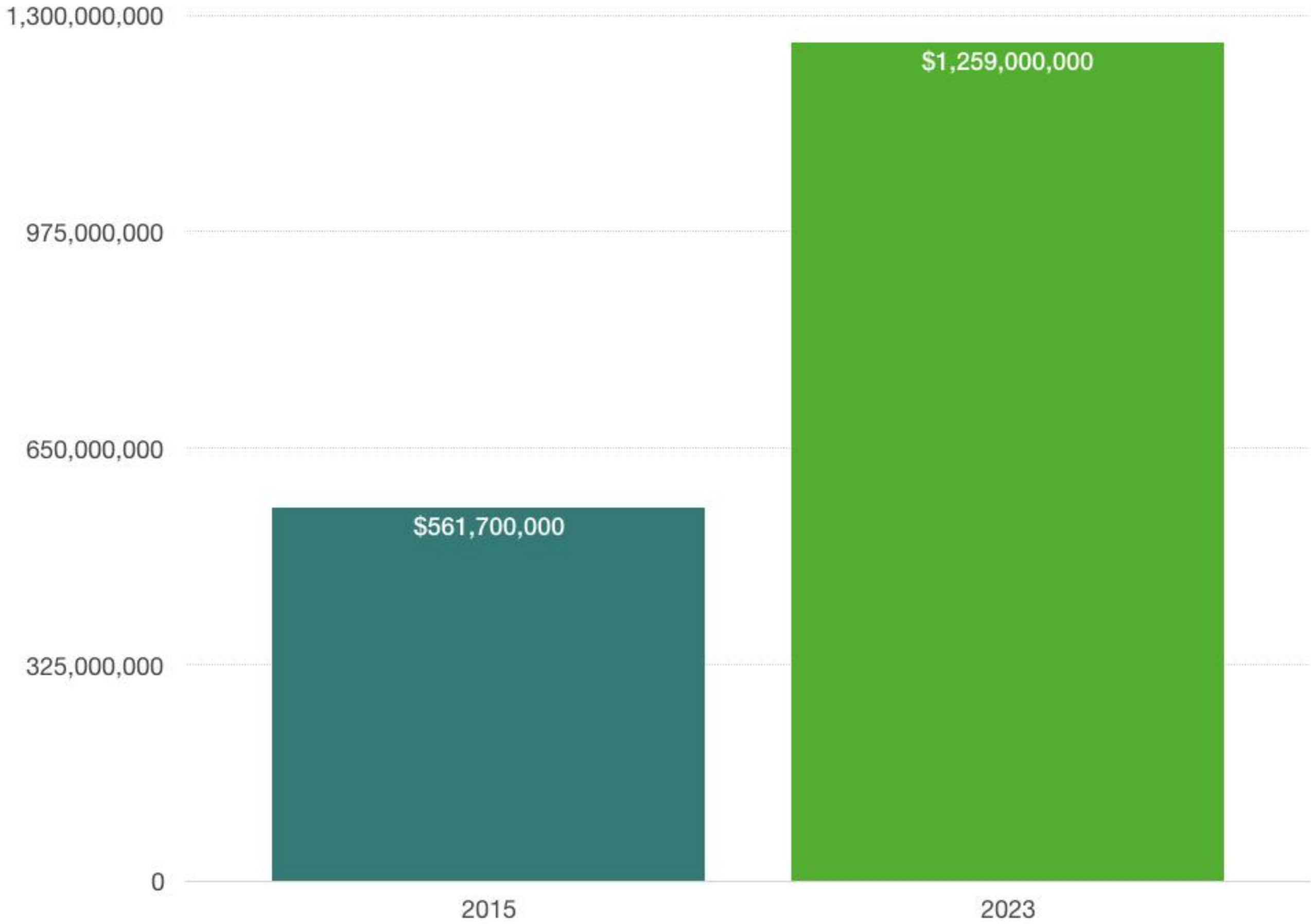

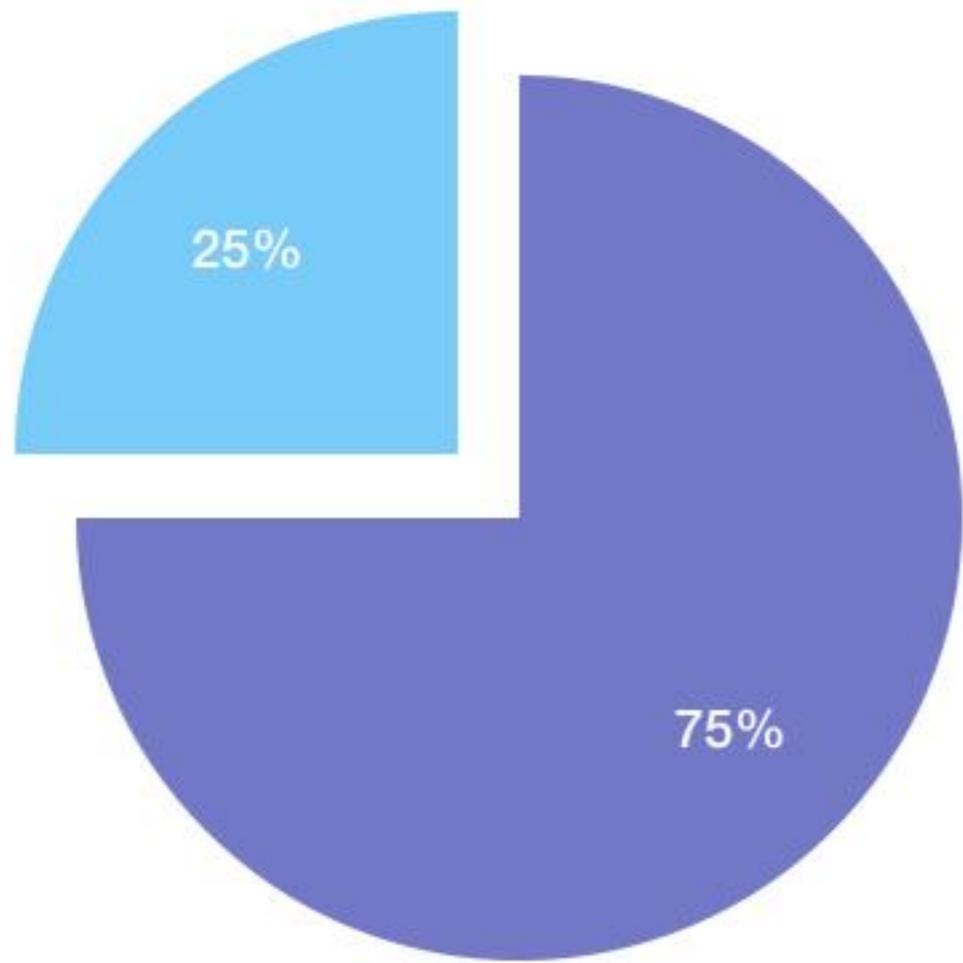

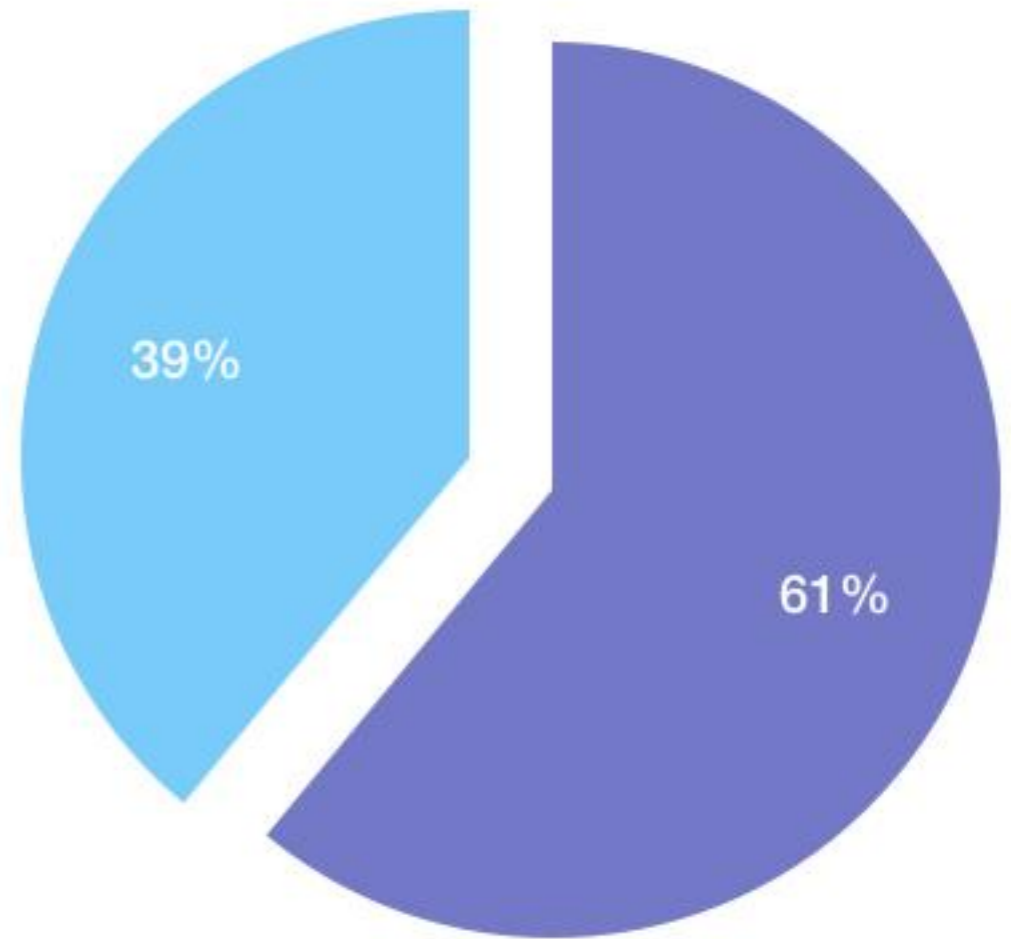


Business Taxes As A Share of N.H. General & Education Trust Fund Revenue

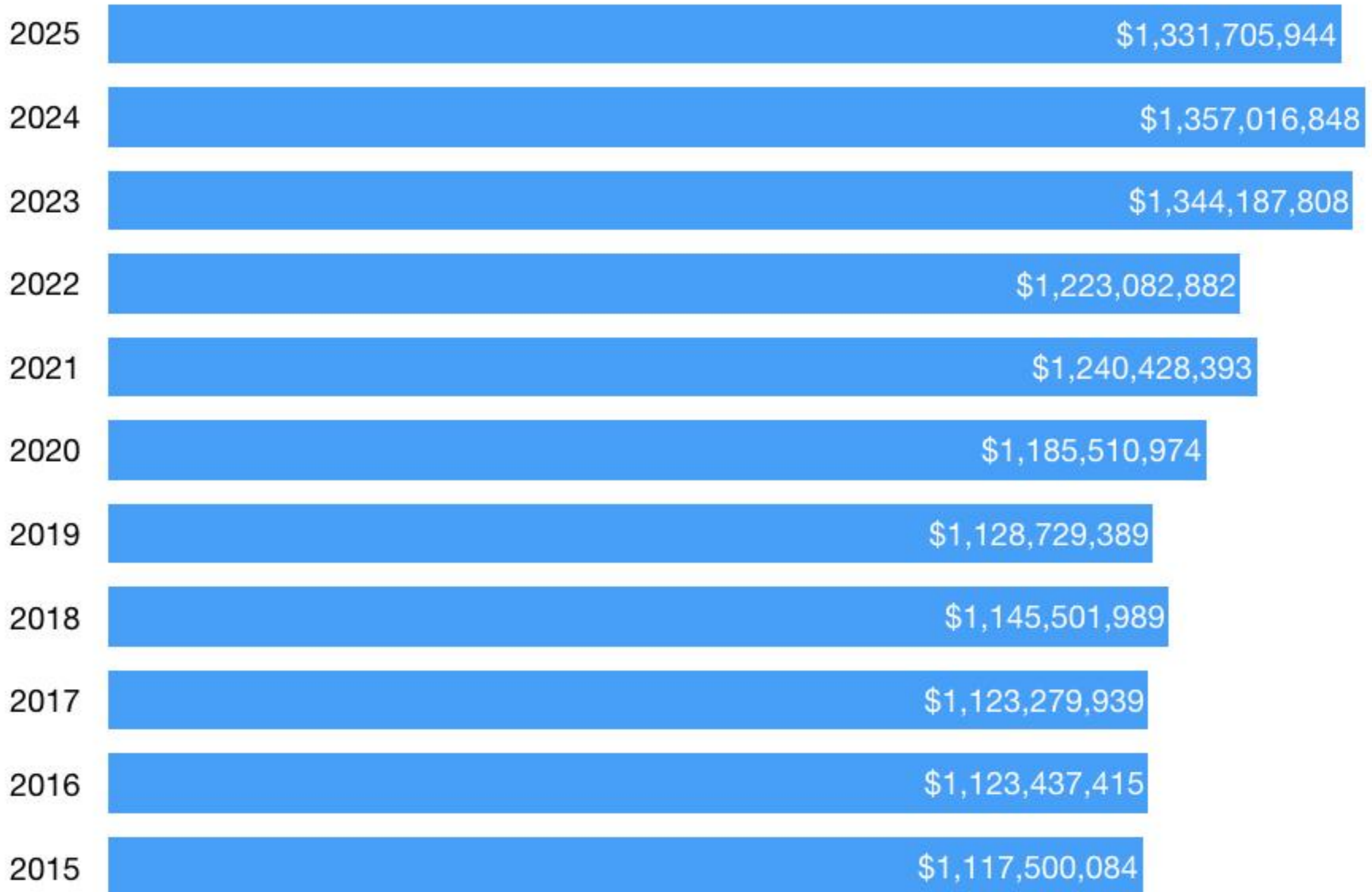

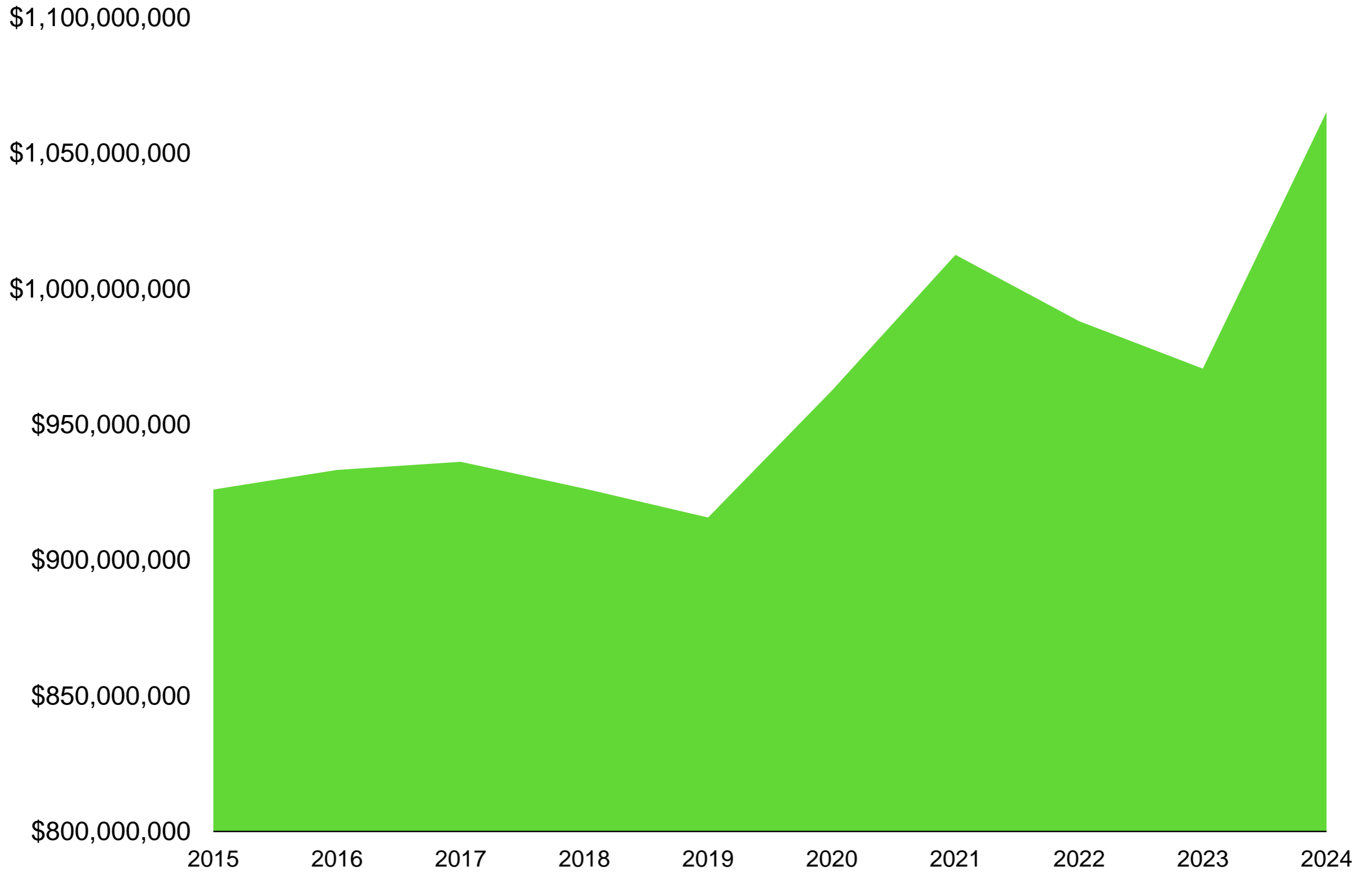

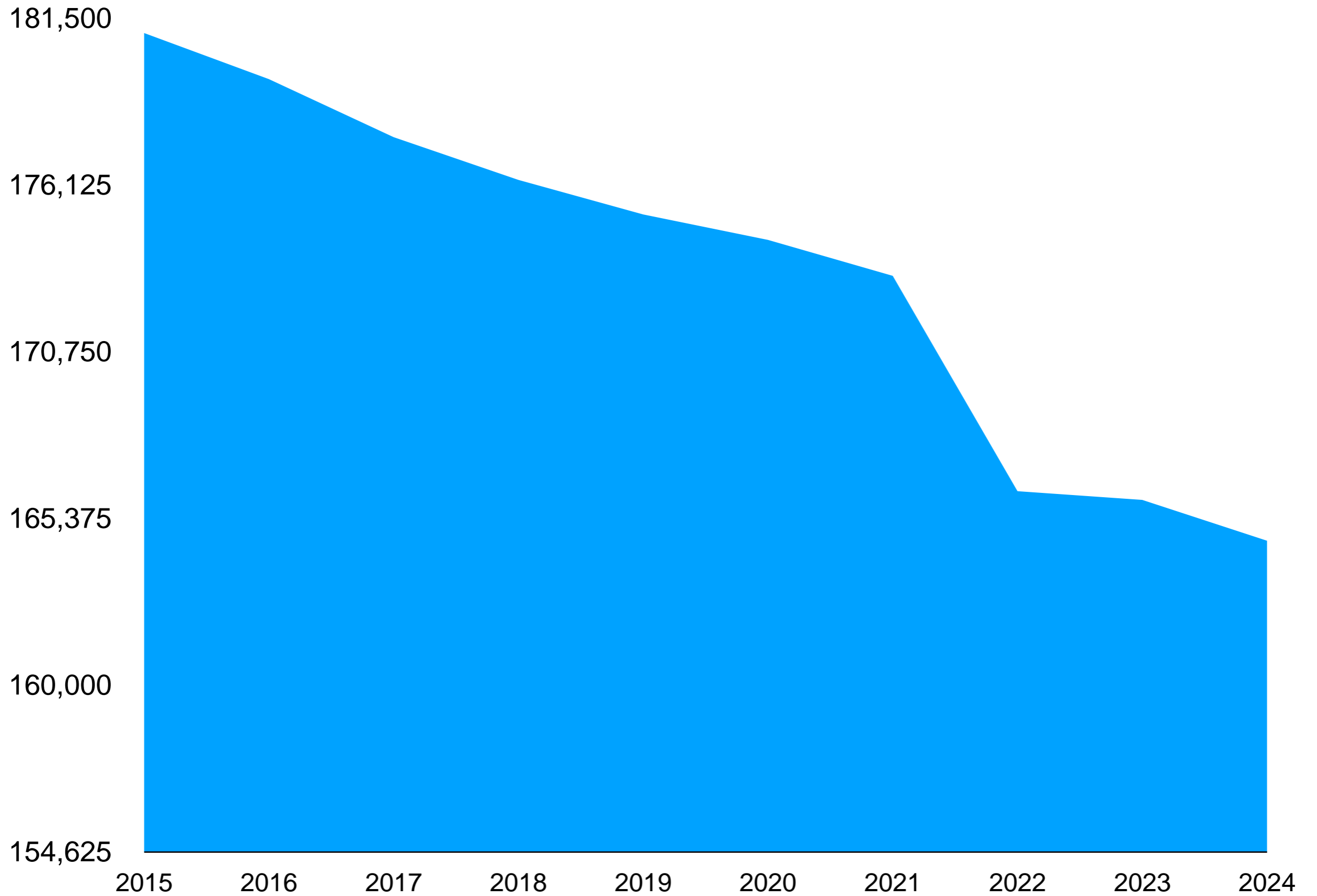
N.H. State Aid To Localities & School Districts 2015-2025



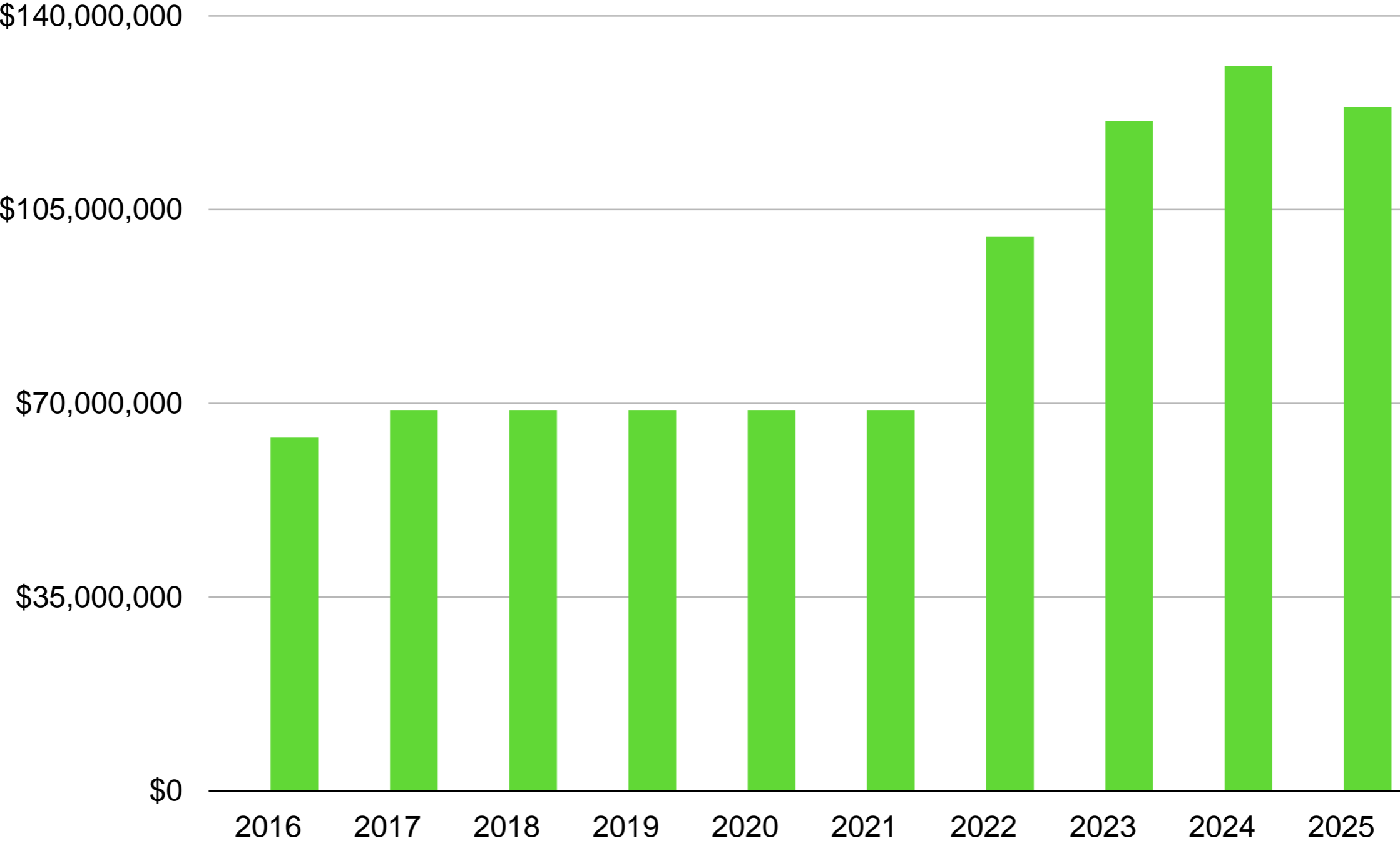
State Adequate Education Aid, 2015-2024

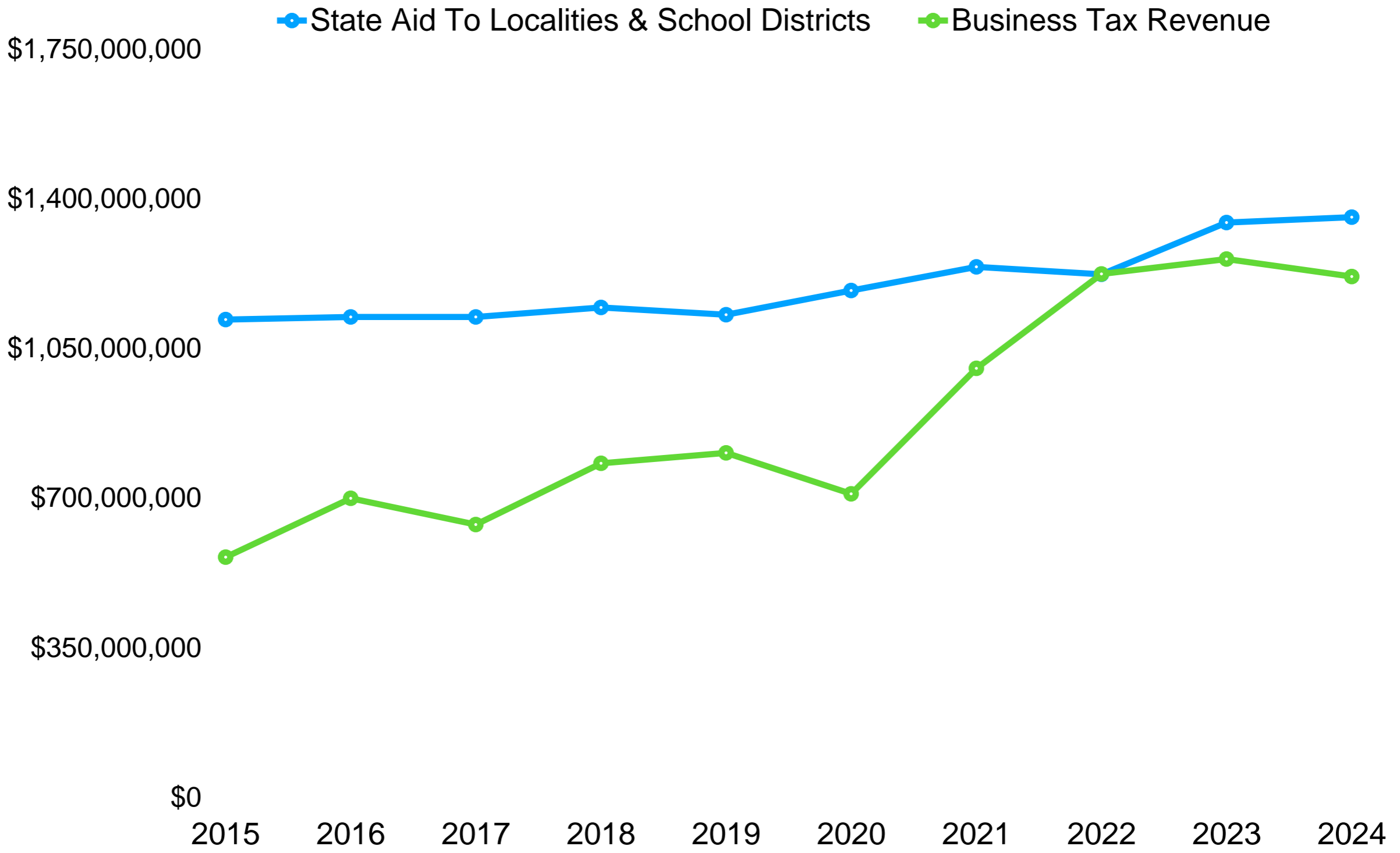


N.H. Public School Enrollment 2015-2024



Meals & Rooms Tax Distribution To Local Governments, 2015-2025



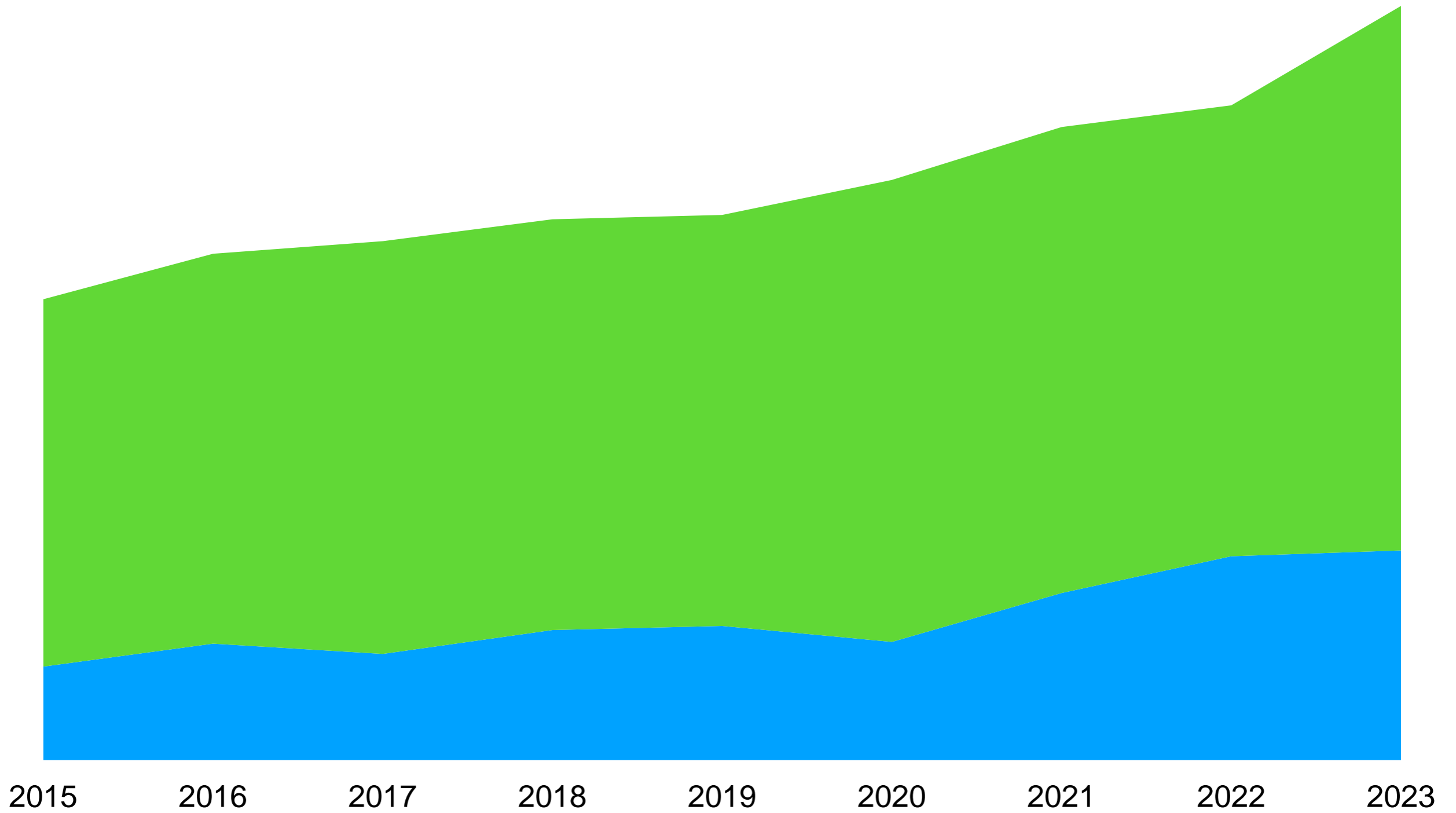

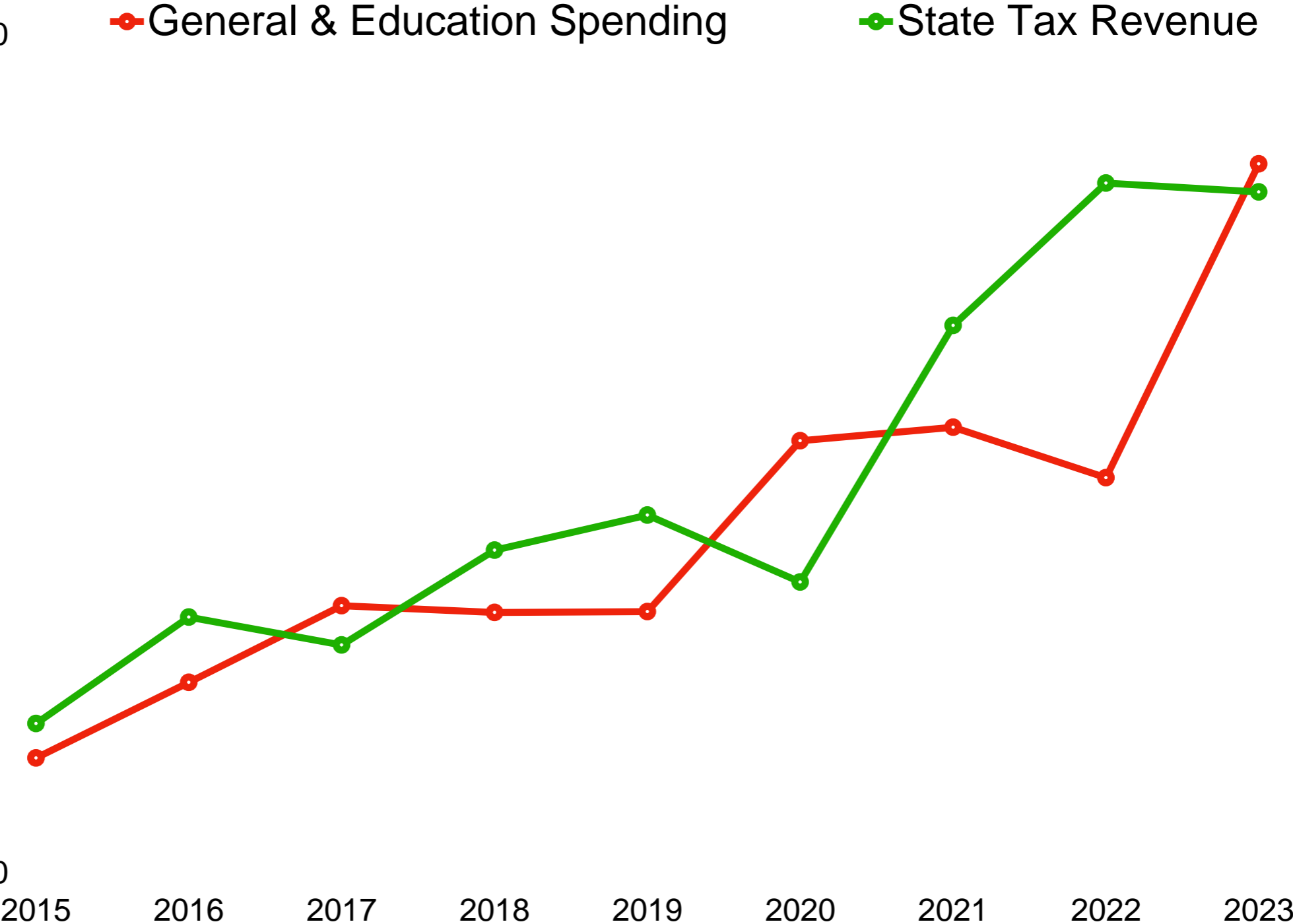

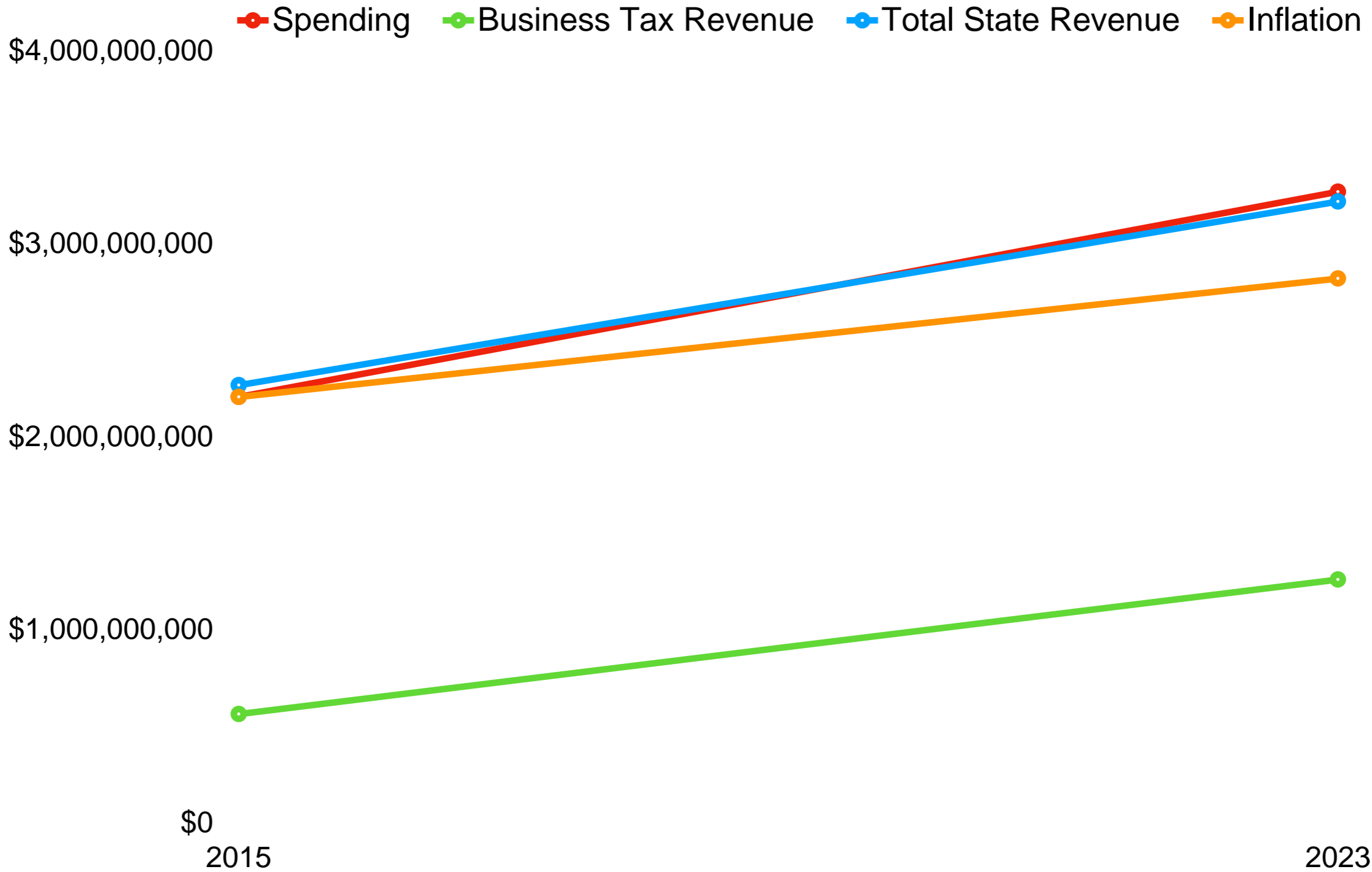

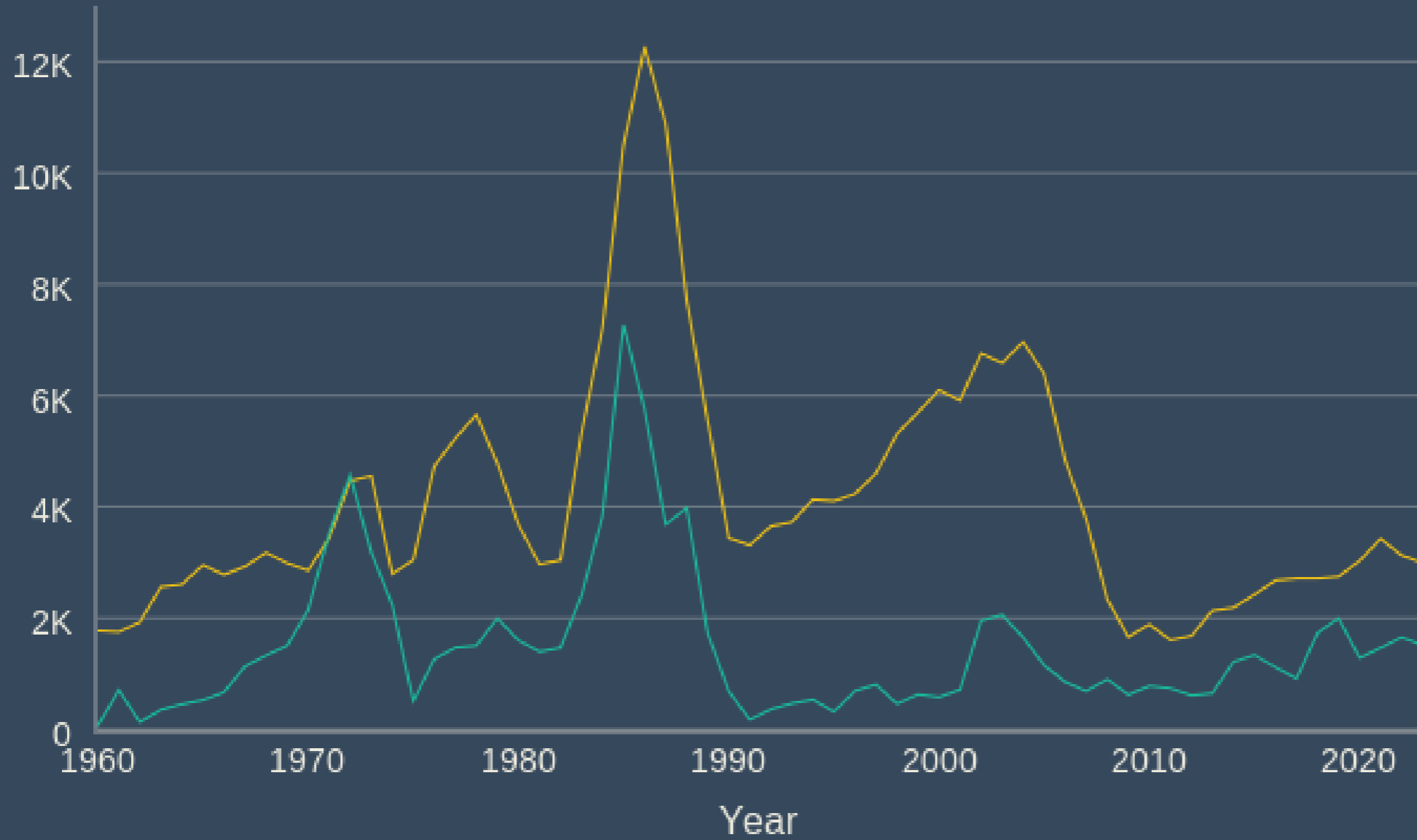

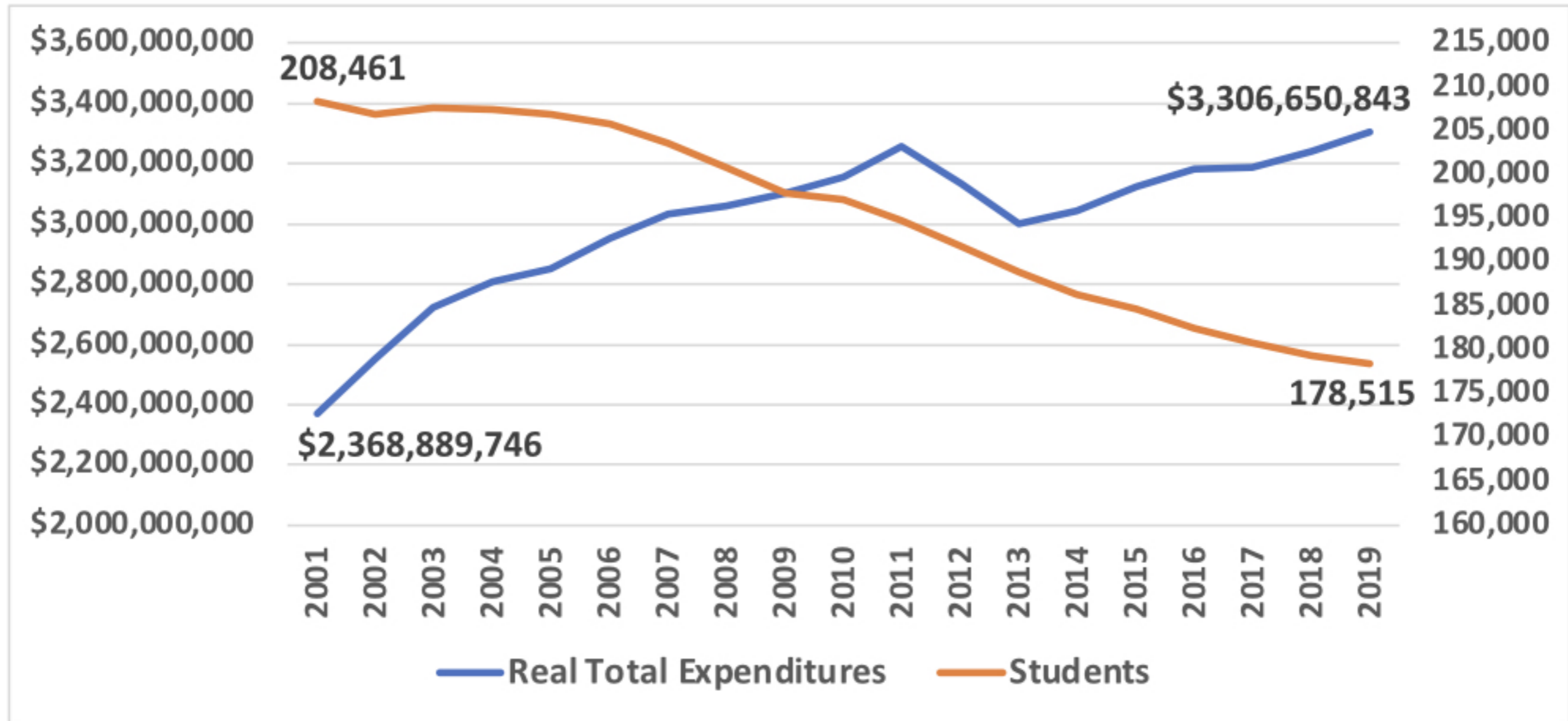

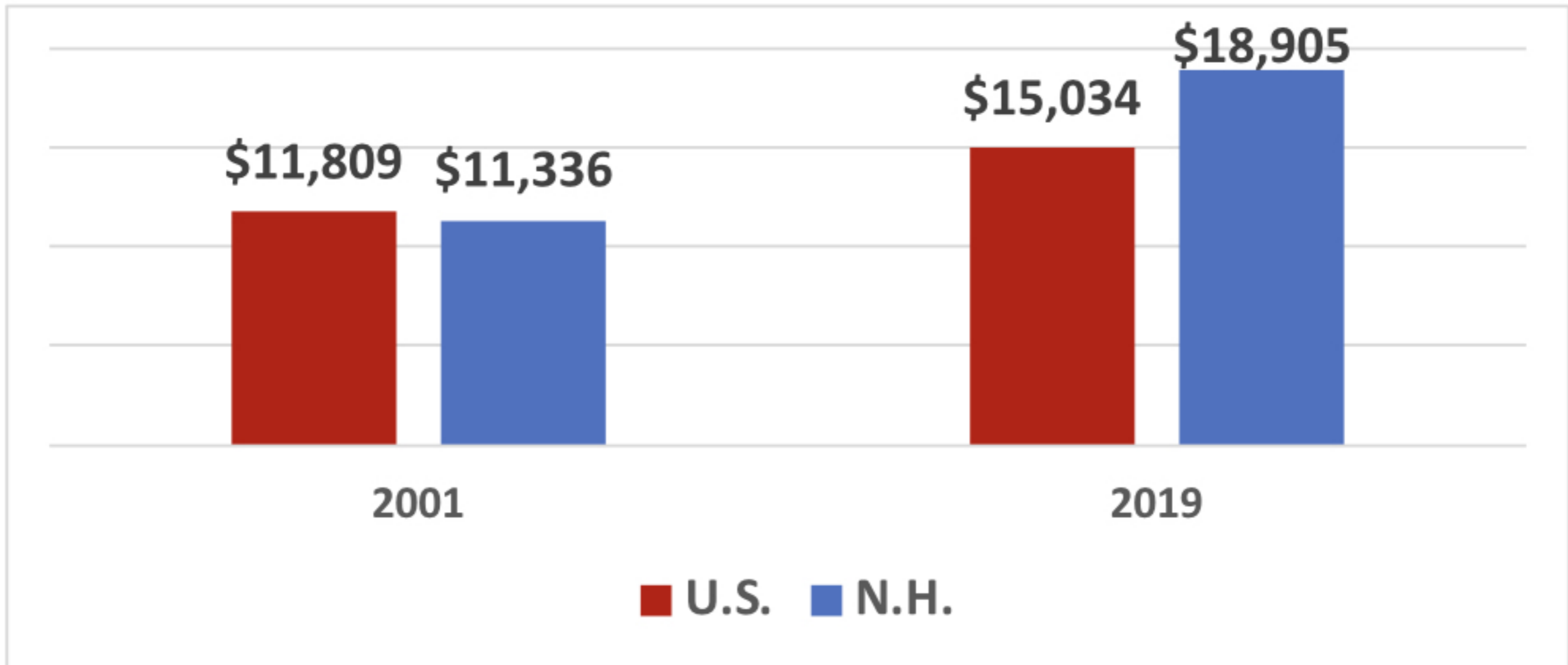

Change in Total FTE State and Local Government Employment in New Hampshire, 2001-2019

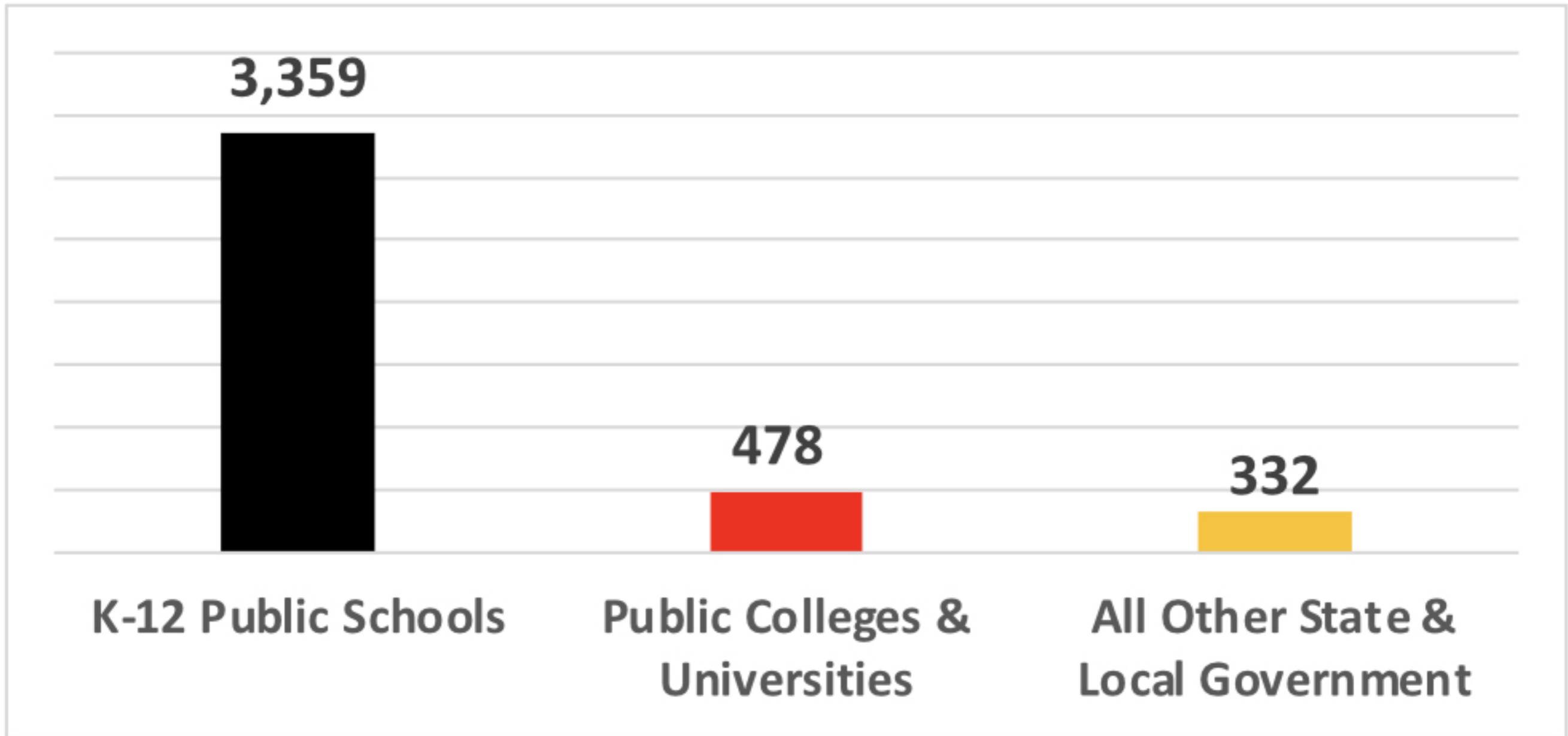


Figure ES.12. Change in NAEP 4th and 8th Grade Reading and Math Scores Between 2003-2019

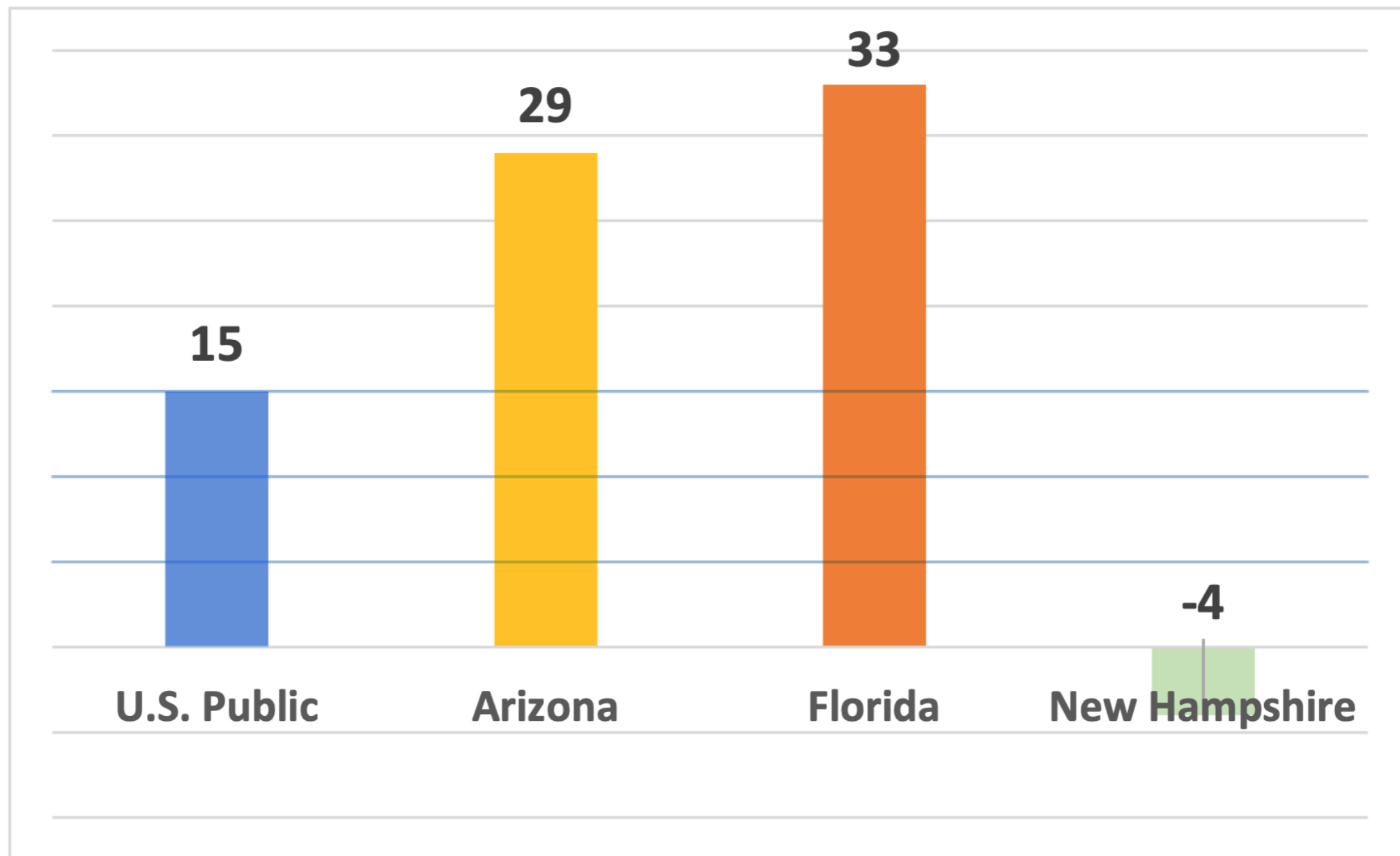


CHART 3. GROWTH IN REAL PERSONAL INCOME, 1977-2012

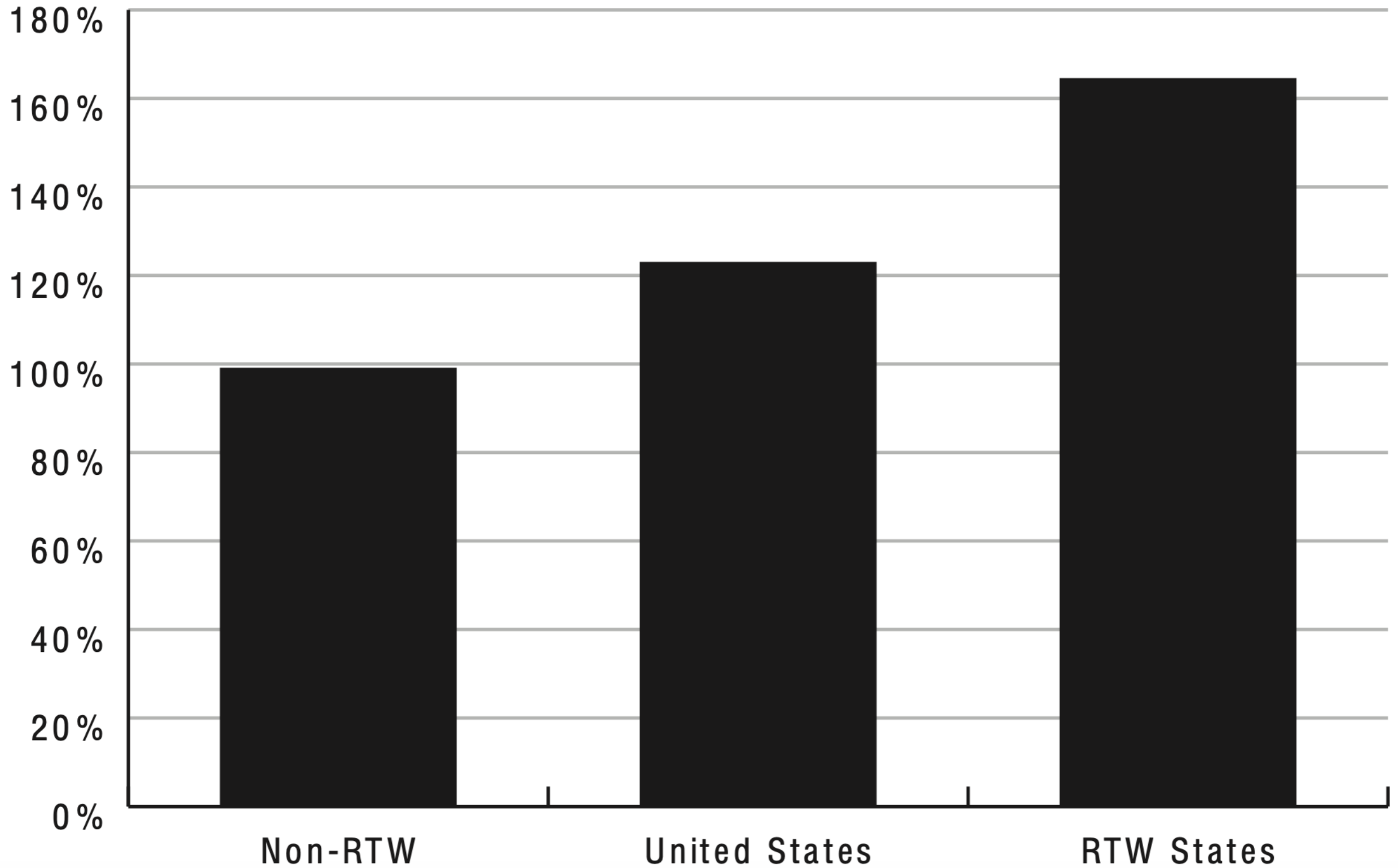
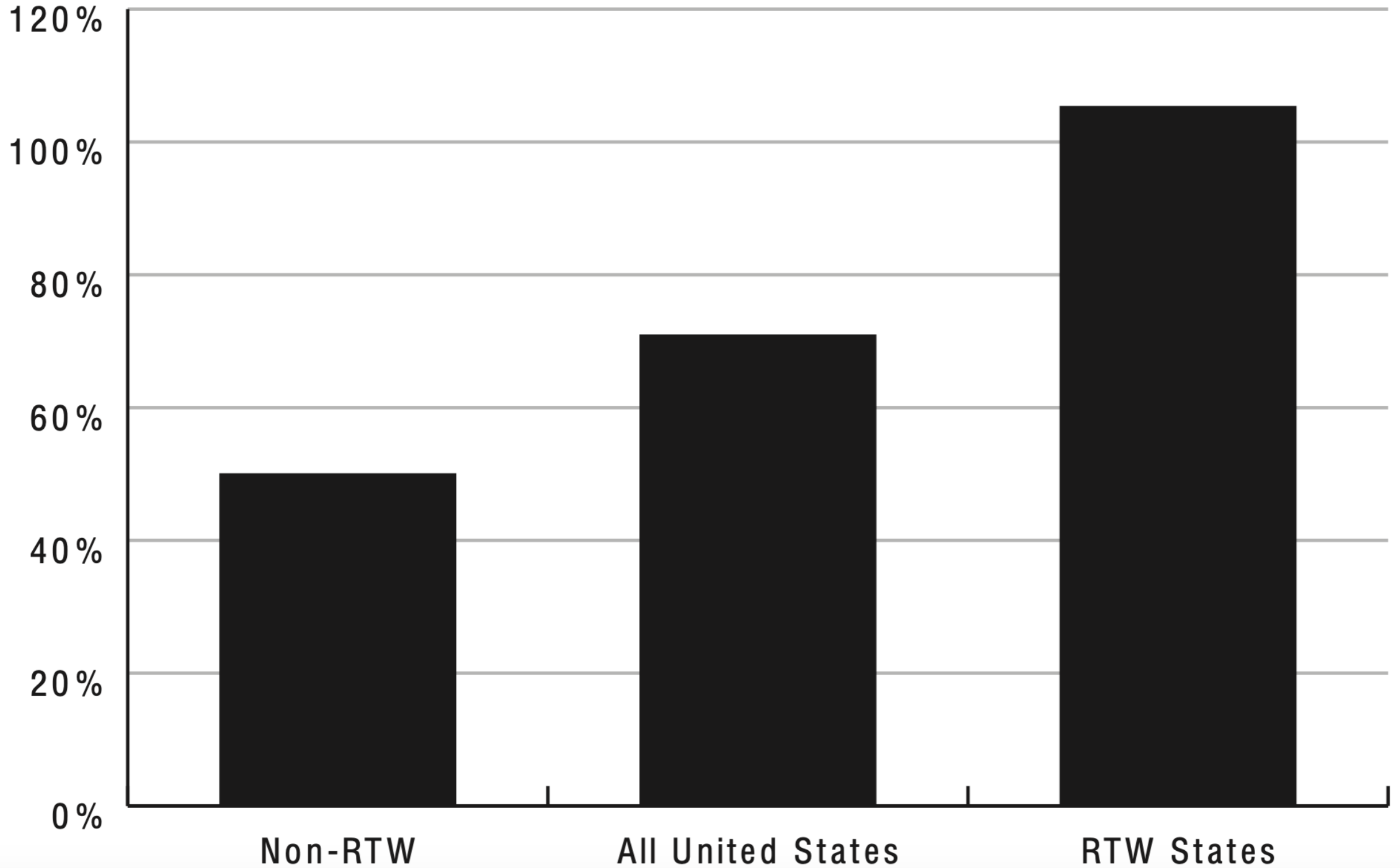


CHART 1. TOTAL EMPLOYMENT GROWTH, 1977-2012

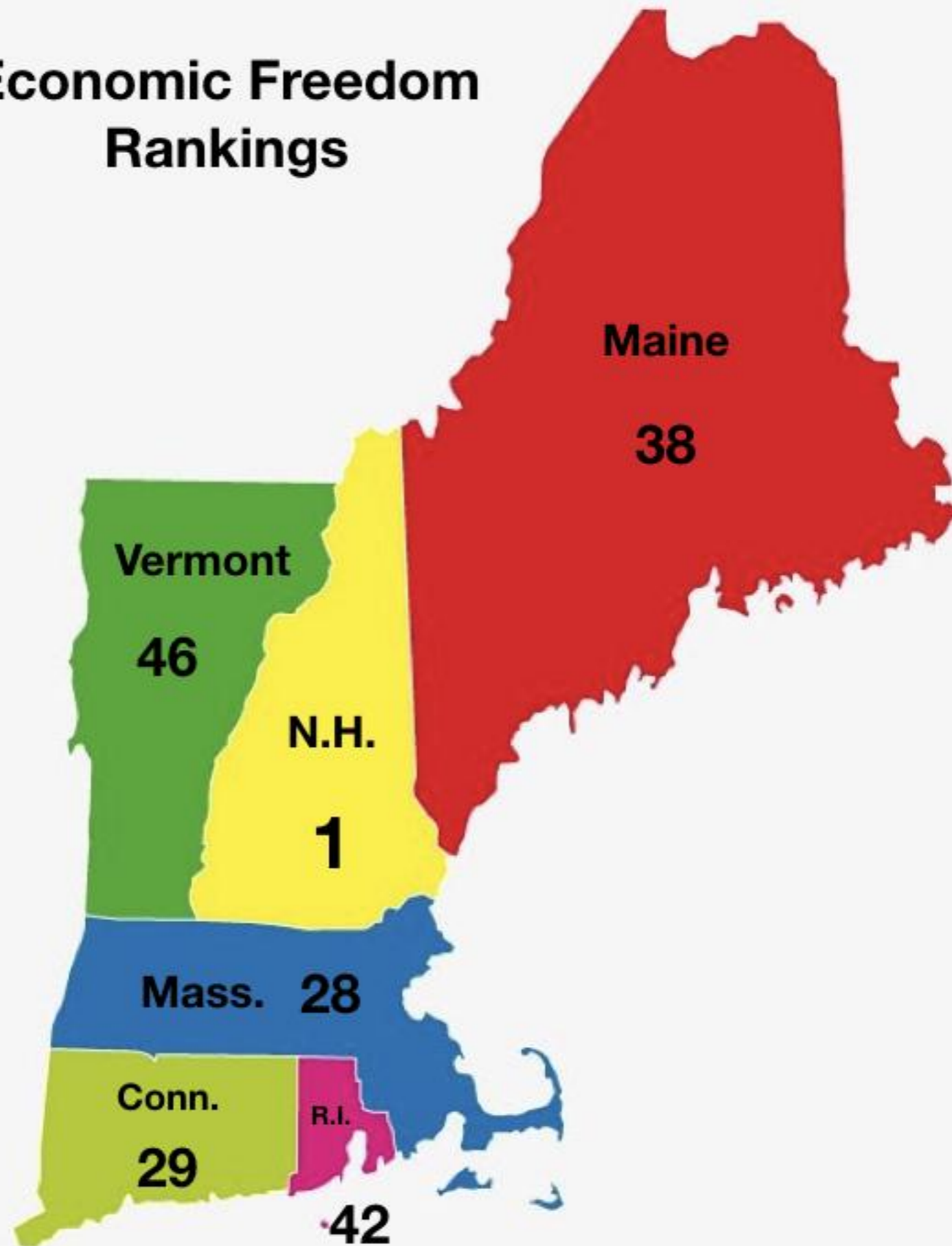


Figure 1.6: US Subnational Economic Freedom and Change in Total Employment from 2013 to 2022

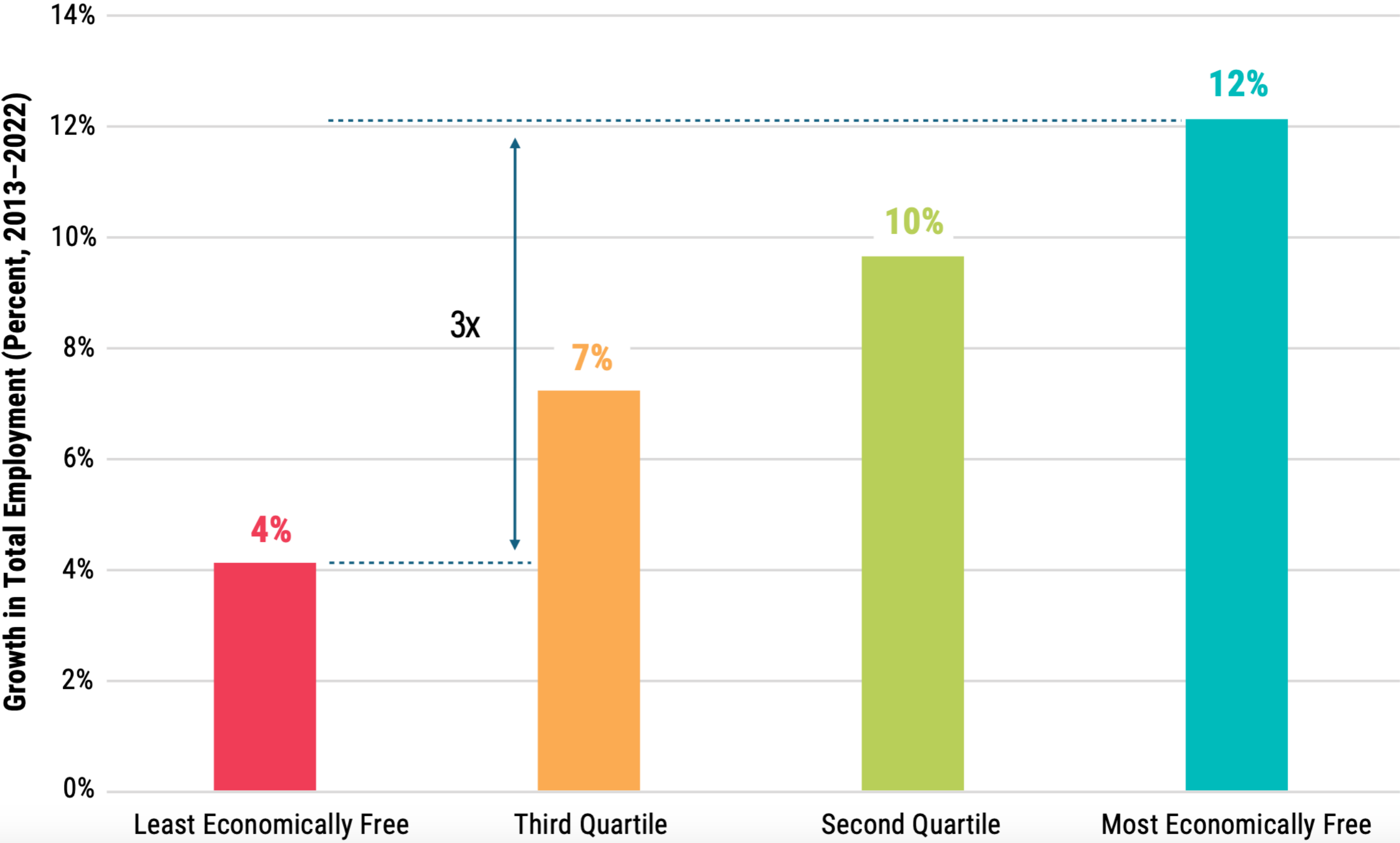


Figure 1.8: Average Growth in Per Capita Income and Average Growth in Economic Freedom at the All-Government Level, 2013–2022
